

Exciting Foundation Announcement WHF-Medline Research Grant Innovation Award \$30,000 Deadline February 28, 2019

The Wound Healing Foundation, through the support of Medline Corius Tissue Regeneration, is delighted to announce a new 3 year grant series; WHF-Medline Research Grant Innovation Award. The first of three consecutive \$30,000 grant awards for the best scientific and innovative proposal will be awarded May 2019.

The purpose of the award is to stimulate innovative wound healing product development. This is a one year, \$30,000 grant awarded to a young investigator doing research in wound healing in the United States. Application proposals should be innovative and likely have the ability to be commercialized in the future. Deadline and application to be finalized and posted soon. The 2019 Innovation recipient benefits by

- Receiving \$30,00 for wound healing product innovation research
- Recognition at the 2019 Wound Healing Society annual meeting in San Antonio, Texas when the award is bestowed
- Recognition on the Wound Healing Foundation website
- Potential to license or sell innovation to any interested commercial parties
- Encouraged to submit completed research for publication in Wound Repair and Regeneration or Advances in Wound Care.

Plan ahead. Begin a patent search and determine what makes your innovation different from prior art in the field. A brief paragraph describing how this innovation could be commercialized and what impact it could have on healing wounds or scars will be required.
